The BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety is a nationally recognised qualification which trains you to identify hazards in your workplace, assist with responding to incidents, assess and control risk and consult on work health and safety issues.

- Understand the requirements and accountability of a safety professional in the workplace
- Understand the legal framework and who is accountable to ensure a safe workplace
- Assist with monitoring a safe workplace
- Effectively consult and communicate on issues relating to the safety and health of the workforce
- Assist in the development of risk management actions
- Contribute to the development of processes and procedures

- **Cost:** Your only financial commitment is \$395 to secure your place which is fully refundable when you are successfully complete. If you are not eligible for funding, you can still do this program at \$1,795.
Program fee includes all materials, assessment, morning and afternoon tea and lunch each day
- **Prerequisites:** There are no formal education prerequisites for entry into this course. However candidates may have already achieved the BSB30712 Certificate III in Work Health and Safety.

Funded places are available to anyone 'on the tools' or 'in the field' in Queensland. It's available to workers who are full time, part time, contractors, self-employed, 3rd and 4th year apprentices and those who have been unemployed no longer than 6 months. OUR 5 DAY PROGRAMS
