BSB51315 Diploma of Work Health and Safety is a nationally recognised program designed for people who coordinate and maintain the work health and safety (WHS) program of an organisation.

In this program you will learn the skills required to be a trusted safety professional in a wide variety of WHS contexts. A key part of a WHS professional and any leader's role is the ability to provide informed advice and leadership as well as to manage risks and investigate incidents. You will learn how to contribute to developing, implementing and maintaining WHS management systems and to analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources in order to provide safety solutions to a range of unpredictable problems.

Learning Outcomes

As a result of this program, learners will:

- Effectively manage WHS consultation and participation processes
- Establish, implement and maintain WHS risk management systems
- Administer WHS information systems, measures and initiatives
- Provide and develop WHS leadership
- Administer and conduct WHS incident investigations
- Facilitate the development and use of hazard-management tools

- **Number of participants:** Up to 20 people
- **Method of delivery:**
This highly interactive program is delivered face-to-face over 3 x 3 day training sessions (total 9 days) over a 3 month period with a relevant project.

Prior to program	Preliminary research and reading to be completed within 2 weeks prior to Module 1.
Module 1	3 days face-to-face undertaking 3 units, followed by 1 month to undertake case study project.
Module 2	3 days face-to-face undertaking 3 units, followed by 1 month to undertake case study project.
Module 3	3 days face-to-face undertaking 3 units, followed by 1 month to undertake case study project.

- **Cost:** Your only financial commitment is a non-refundable gap fee of \$395 which secures your place. If you are not eligible for funding, you can still do this program at \$2,995.

Program fee includes all materials, assessment, morning and afternoon tea and lunch each day

- **Prerequisites:**
The prerequisites for this course are the 5 core units of BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety.

For those who are without the required prerequisites, Workplace Dimensions also offers a pathway WHS program - BSB41415 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety.

Learners must also have sound literacy skills to enable them to adequately interpret text such as WHS legislation.
